

THE 2008 FELT TOUR DE PARK CITY

The 2008 Tour de Park City USCF sanctioned race offers race participants the opportunity to challenge each other through some of Utah's most beautiful mountains and mountain valleys. The course features fast flats, great climbs, and fast descents. The climb takes riders to an elevation of 10,700 feet at Bald Mt. Pass atop the Mirror Lake Highway. The race will be fully supported eliminating the need to have your own support vehicle which means you only have to worry about one thing.....racing!

The Felt Tour de Park City presented by Felt Bicycles takes riders starting from the Newpark Hotel/Basin Recreation Center riding towards Kamas via Hwy 248. The route then takes a left onto Browns Canyon Road. From Browns Canyon riders will follow Hwy 32 to Coalville where they will turn onto Chalk Creek Road. Racers ride all the way to Evanston Wyoming where the course turns onto Hwy 150 (Mirror Lake Highway). Highway 150 will take riders downhill to Kamas and Highway 248. From here they ride back to the Newpark/Basin Recreation Center to the finish line. Over the 170 mile course, racers start at 6,300 feet and climb 9,544 feet and descend the same. RULES

All USCF Rules apply. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO KNOW THE USCF RACE RULES. ANSI or SNELL Helmets are required. Helmets must be worn at all times when riding your bike. Please dress for heat of the summer as well as the cool of the mountains.

RACE SUPPORT

Aid stations will be located every 25 miles along the course. Aid stations will be on the right hand side of the road. Racers may stop at the aid stations or may request full bottles of water or drink and any food that looks appealing. Aid station volunteers will be available to hand-off food or full bottles to race riders. Please do not throw trash along the roadside. Trash and empty bottles may be given to volunteers at any aid station or to SAG vehicles or support vehicles along the course. Aid stations will remain open until all race participants have passed.
